SURREALE RESIDENCY CALL

APPLICATION CALL 2020

The Società Ginnastica di Torino / FLIC Circus School is the organising body behind “Surreale – contemporary circus residencies”, which is supported by MIBAC (Ministry of Cultural Heritage and Activities) and the Region of Piedmont within the project “Artisti nei Territori”. The aim of this residency programme is to identify potential circus projects which to support, within their individual programme of artistic residencies.

RESIDENCY CONDITIONS

Art.1 – Objective of the Residency Call

The purpose of the call is to identify contemporary circus artists and companies who know how to interpret circus language in a multidisciplinary way, through the use of different scenic and narrative languages.

Art. 2 – Who can participate

The call is aimed at:

- Companies who come from the European territory, who wish to develop a full-length show;
- Single artists who come from the European territory, who are under 35 and have just completed an artistic training in circus and who want to develop a project in a short form of 20 minutes. Priority will be given to projects composed of single or duo artists.

Amateur companies and entities with formal Artistic Residency programmes are excluded from this call.

Art. 3 – Deadlines and schedule

The projects must be sent by e-mail according to the terms illustrated in art. 7, no later than **20th of March 2020 at 23:59 GMT +1**. The first selection phase will take place by **25th of March 2020**.

Art. 4 – The selections

First selection phase: the projects received via email will be selected by the artistic direction of FLIC Circus School by 25th of March 2020.

Second selection phase: the selected artists are invited to the Teatro Concordia in Venaria Reale (TO) on the 18th of April 2020 to present a presentation of maximum 10 minutes orally, which will be evaluated by a commission composed of

sector operators. The presentations will not be in the form of a show, but verbal, and the selected companies / artists will be able to use video, photographic, paper or other material to convey the sense of the artistic project. **The project can be presented by one single person, as long as this person is an integral part of the artistic project.**

Selection criteria: the criteria of judgment will be the multidisciplinary feature of the project, the theme in relation to the realization, the artistic and / or the training curriculum.

Art. 5 – Support available to the winners

The judgment of the commission is final and will award a maximum of 4 projects, of which one company and three single artists under 35.

The selected Company will receive: 15 days of artistic residency during 2020 at Spazio FLIC in Turin, a support to the creation of € 5000.00 including food, accommodation and travel costs, and the pre-achat of the show to be included in the 2021 season of FLIC circus school.

The individual artists (under 35), be they single or duo artists, will receive: 15 days of artistic residency in 2020 at Spazio FLIC in Turin with a sum of € 2100.00 which will include costs relating to employment contracts of the artists/ technicians for the period of residency and support for the creation (tutorials, sets, equipment, studio audio lights, etc). The short forms of the three selected individual artists will constitute a whole evening that will be presented in 2021 within the FLIC circus school's show season.

By **residency**, it is meant as a working period of 15 days, not necessarily consecutive, at Spazio FLIC. Spazio FLIC is an open space of 700 square meters, equipped for circus disciplines, with changing rooms, showers and bathrooms, and is equipped with audio and stage lighting.

In the event that the commission deems that the submitted projects do not meet the artistic criteria of the call, the commission may choose, at its sole discretion, to select **less than 4 projects or no project at all.**

Art. 6 – Obligations of the companies /artists (both for first selections and winning phases)

The company and the artists selected through "Surreale" Residency Call are committed to ensuring their participation in the second selection phase, supporting all necessary expenses for the trip.

The winning companies / artists are required to guarantee their presence for the 15 day artistic residency during the period between July and December 2020, to be agreed upon based on existing activities of FLIC Circus School.

The winning company and artists are required to indicate, in all public and promotional materials related to the selected project, the words: "with the support of RSGT / FLIC - Residenza Surreale".

Art. 7 – Procedure for participation in the residency call

To participate in the residency call, it is necessary to send the fully completed Participation Form to the email address **info@flicscuolacirco.it**; using the subject title "Call Surreale 2020" and sending by no later than the 20th of March 2020 at 23:59 GMT +1. Compulsory attachments are also required: project description, curriculum vitae of the artist, company or members of the company; valid identity document of the project manager. Participants can send other descriptive, poetic, photographic and video material to support the application.

Art. 8 – Communication of the results

The outcome of the first selection will be published by the 25th of March 2020 on the FLIC circus school's website **www.flicscuolacirco.it**. The outcome of the second selection will be communicated in the same way following the selection of the commission no later than the 24th of April 2020. The training will receive a direct communication to the email addresses indicated in the Application Form.

Art. 9 – Privacy

The data collected for this call will be processed in accordance with Italian Legislative Decree, 30 June 2003, n. 196 "Code regarding personal data" and the GDPR (European Regulation 2016/679).
